Please take good care of it!

Please do not wear this costume as dress up prior to our show day.

Any lost, misplaced, or damaged costumes cannot be replaced.

We will not have and do not have extra hair accessories, bows, gloves, belts, etc. If your costume came with an accessory please keep track of it - we will not be able to give you another one if it is lost. Any students with lost accessories will go on stage without one.

**LABEL INSIDE TAG ON EVERY COSTUME AND DANCE SHOES WITH YOUR NAMES!!!**

*Included in this bag are all the items you need for your costume.*

*Please read on for Hair, Make Up, and additional tips.*

**TIGHTS**

- All Mini Movers, Tini Dancers and Twirl/Tumble classes **NO TIGHTS - BARE LEGS**  
Please wear the provided socks with bare legs. This makes bathroom trips easier for our staff.
- If your class requires tights they are included inside your costume bag.
- Hip Hop costumes (male/female) with PANTS - **YOU DO NOT NEED TIGHTS.** You may wear socks and sneakers.
- All female costumes with pants must still wear the provided tights under their pants. No socks with your dance shoes.
- All male dancers must provide their own no show or black socks
- Make sure you pack your dance shoes when headed to the stage!!!

## Hair Style

**See Below For: Mini Movers - Tini Dancers - Twirl/Tumble - Tot Hop - Kid Combo - Hippity Hop**

Please pull your hair back into a HIGH BUN at the crown of their head. You may use a bun maker (donut) to make a nice full looking bun. If there is a headpiece with your costume please place it on the DANCERS RIGHT side of the bun.



**See Below For : All other classes not listed above**

Please pull your hair back into a LOW BUN with a part in the center of your head. You may use a bun maker (donut) to make a nice full looking bun. If there is a headpiece with your costume please place it on the DANCERS RIGHT side of the bun.



- First, please use hair gel to neatly slick back the hair into your assigned hair style.
- Next, secure down fly aways and loose hairs using hair spray.
- All hair should be securely geld and sprayed tight to the scalp.
- If your hair is too short for the above hairstyle, please tie the front half back off your face and secure it with a small elastic or bobby pins leaving the rest of the hair down.
- Male dancers with long-ish hair please gel hair into a neat hairstyle and out of the eyes.

## Make - Up

All dancers should wear a little bit of makeup, even the youngest kiddos. Stage lighting is very bright and it washes out the skin and facial features. Using a little bit of makeup helps to see their faces under the bright lighting. If you are against using makeup on your child, you may choose to skip this step.

- On the younger dancers a little bit of lipstick, blush and eye shadow is all they need.
- Older dancers can wear lipstick, eye shadow, eye liner, mascara, blush and foundation.
- A Red Tone Lip is best seen under the bright stage lights. Pinks are usually washed out.
- Eyeshadow of browns, grays, and neutrals are best. Stay away from purples and blues
- Blush is typically one shade darker than you would wear on a normal day to day basis.

## Additional Tips + Tricks

- Dancers with many costumes to carry and keep track of may use a small laundry basket to hold everything and keep it all contained backstage
- Dancers with sensitive skin (or many costume changes) may purchase a skin toned leotard to wear underneath their costumes. This keeps itchy fabric off sensitive skin and keeps privacy if you need to change backstage. We sell these at the studio if you need one or you can purchase them at any dancewear store.
- Label Everything!!! And we mean Everything! Things often go missing between picture day, dress rehearsal and show day and we will not know who to get items back to if you do not label them. Also if your whole class is changing shoes in the same area, shoes often get swapped easily. LABEL EVERYTHING!
